

## **SEVERE WEATHER**

The Camp Director will notify unit leaders as to the forecast of any immediate severe weather event (tornado, severe thunderstorms, hurricane, smog alert, extreme temperature/ humidity).

### Tornado, Hurricane, Severe Storm, Imminent Flooding-

1. Staff will be assembled and assigned to go to campsites. Staff will load scouts and leaders to the nearest building.
2. The following is a list of campsites and the nearest evacuation point.  
Nathan Hale and Baden Powell- Weed Lodge  
Tunxis, Kahagon, Seton and Dan Beard Pioneer- Griffin Lodge  
Tee Pee, Outpost, Drake and Frontier, Nodine N/S- Chapel
3. If caught in the midst of any severe storm, you should seek shelter in a low protected area, Be aware of the danger from falling limbs and lightning.

### Lightning , Small Craft Warning-

1. If a small craft warning issued, or thunder or lightning is heard or spotted, the Waterfront Director will order all boats and swimmers off the lake.
2. All waterfront activities will be suspended until at least one- half hour ( at the discretion of the director) after the lightning has stopped.

### Extreme Temperature/ Humidity, Smog Alert-

During a period of high temperatures and/ or humidity, and during smog alerts, hiking and any activities involving strenuous physical activity may be curtailed at the discretion of the Camp Director.
