

## **MAJOR ACCIDENT**

1. Staff Members at the scene will assume immediate responsibility.
2. Radio contact will be established with Camp Director. A runner will also be sent to ensure radio contact was established.
3. Proper first aid measures will be carried out by qualified personnel.
4. The Camp Director or Health Officer will initiate contact with the authorities.

## **EVACUATION**

The Camp Director, in consultation with the Scout Executive, may order an evacuation of the camp due to a medical emergency or severe weather.

1. If the decision to evacuate the camp is made, campers and staff will bring clothing and needs for two days to the parade ground.
2. Buses will bring the campers and staff to the designed emergency shelters in the area.
3. When the emergency has passed and camp is secured, movement back to camp will be authorized by the Camp Director.

NOTE: The Winsted and Torrington areas are in valleys and are flood zones. In the event of a flood, the evacuation point is the camp. (high ground-dining hall)

4. In the event of a medical evacuation, the Camp Director will notify the local Health District.
